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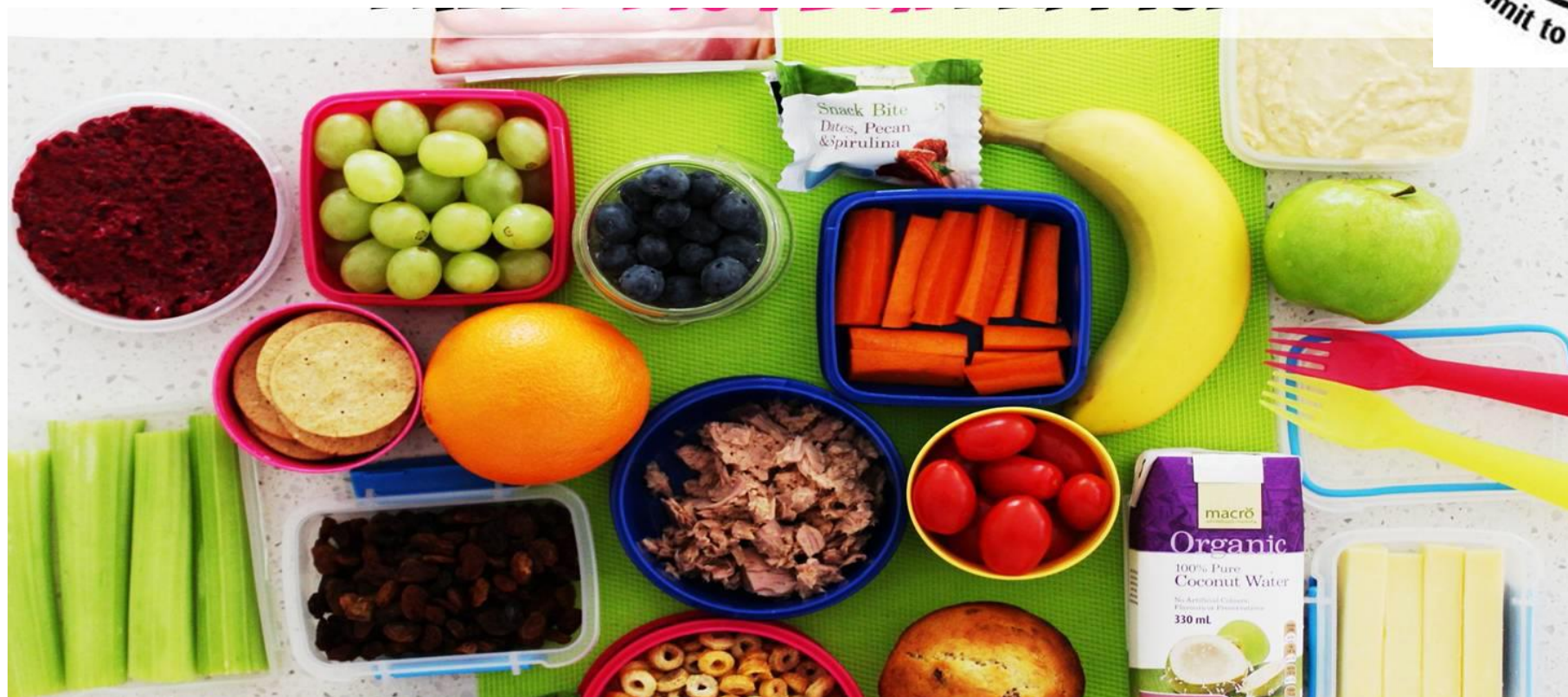
Late day and Supplementary, Enrichment and remedial (SER) classes

Thursdays	Math / Mother Tongue	2pm / 3.15pm

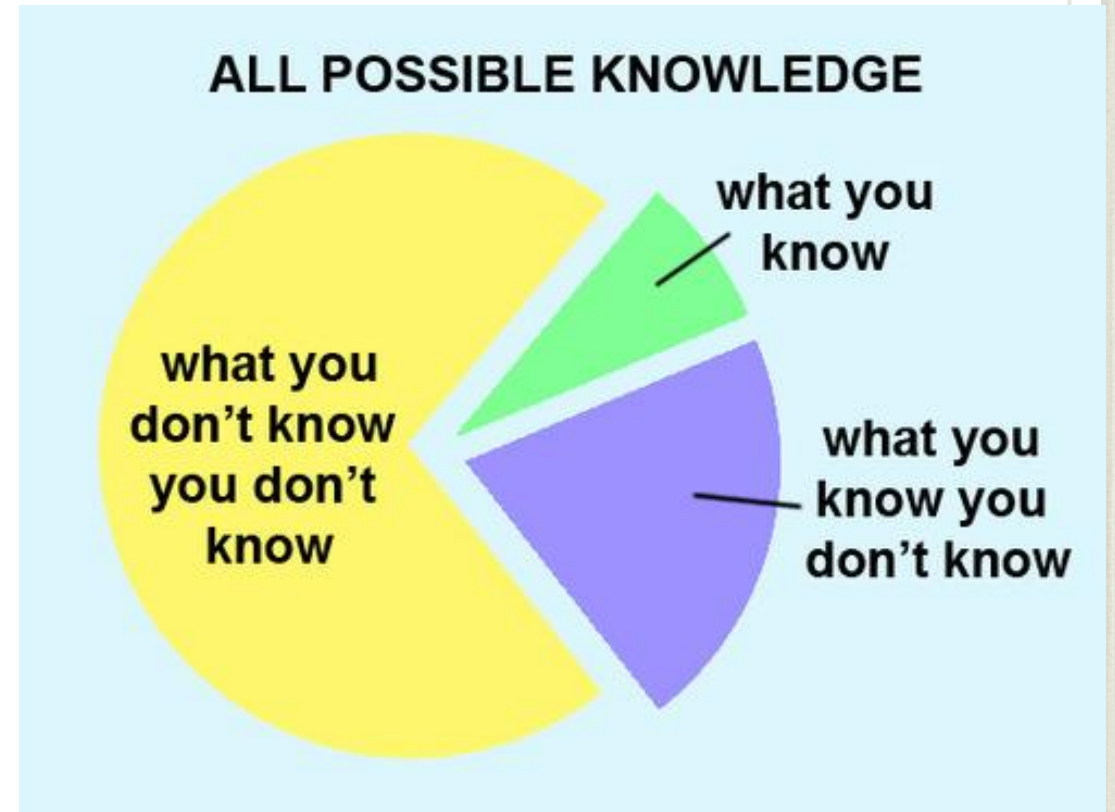

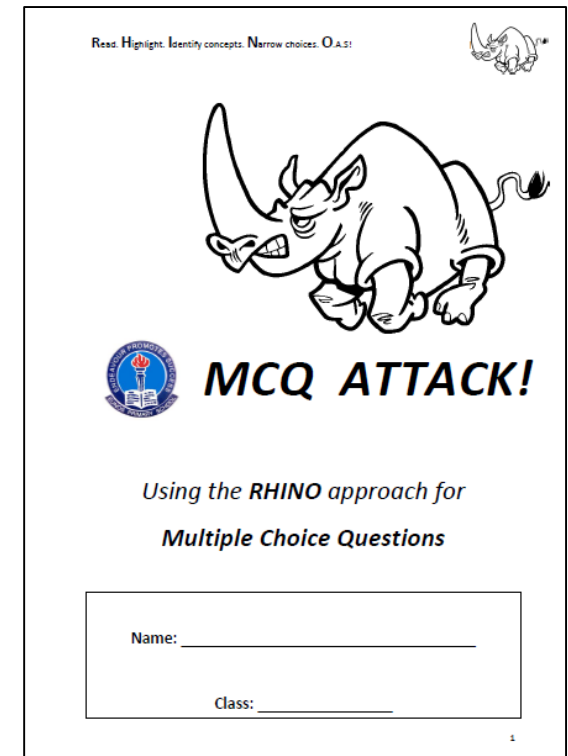
